Beatrice RANA, Italy

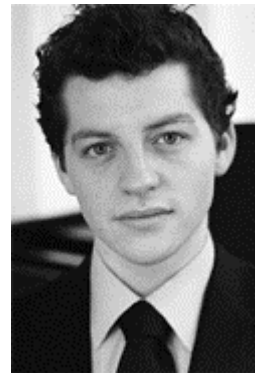

The MIMC, founded in 2002 at the initiative of the Jeunesses Musicales of Canada, plays a key role in the finest tradition of classical concert music. The Competition seeks to discover, reward and support young singers, violinists and pianists who have distinguished themselves as masters of their art. Since the very first edition, dedicated to voice, in 2002, near 2000 candidates applied to take part in various editions, and of these, 306 were given the opportunity to perform in Montreal, to the great delight of music lovers. Next edition: Voice 2012, Violin 2013 and Piano 2014.
