

RICHARD LUPIEN IMPROVISATION PRIZE, FIRST EDITION: AND THE WINNER IS...

THE MONTREAL INTERNATIONAL MUSICAL COMPETITION, 2014 PIANO EDITION KICKS OFF NEXT MONDAY, MAY 26

Montreal, May 20, 2014 — The Montreal International Musical Competition (MIMC) announces that the international jury—made up of Mr. François Dompierre (Canada), also President of the jury, Mr. Bruno Fontaine (France), and Ms. Gabriela Montero (Venezuela)—has chosen Mr. Serhiy Salov, from Ukraine, as the Grand Prize winner of the first edition of the Richard Lupien Improvisation Prize, which was held this afternoon in Tanna Schulich Hall at McGill University. The laureate received a \$5,000 grant. It is worth mentioning that Serhiy Salov was also the winner of the First Prize at the first piano edition of the MIMC, in 2004.

The MIMC wishes to congratulate each of the 6 participants that took part in this new prize, which is seeking to promote classical piano improvisation, a traditional discipline still taught in some higher music education institutions. The MIMC stands out among the 115 competitions in the World Federation of International Music Competitions by being the first to offer such an award. According to Mr. Richard Lupien, today we witnessed the true meaning of "the art of living in the present and to the fullest!"

The Richard Lupien Improvisation Prize was broadcast live on <u>medici.tv</u> and will be available internationally for on demand listening for three months.
