

# SIX YOUNG PIANISTS, AMONG WHICH TWO CANADIANS, REACH THE FINALS OF THE MONTREAL INTERNATIONAL MUSICAL COMPETITION

# Finalists play concerto of choice with the Orchestre symphonique de Montréal

Montreal, May 31, 2014 — The semi-finals of the Montreal International Musical Competition (MIMC) came to a close tonight as the international jury, presided by Mr. André Bourbeau, selected six finalists. Following the Quarter-Final round in which 24 competitors from 15 countries competed at Salle Bourgie between May 26 and 28, twelve semi-finalists took the same stage on May 30 and 31. "While we can only select six for the Finals, I am extremely proud of all our candidates. They are talented and incredibly brave. It takes a lot of determination for them, and in such a short time, to prepare for a Competition of this calibre," said Christiane LeBlanc, Executive and Artistic Director of the MIMC.
