You will recall that the CMIM announced on March 17 the postponement of its 2020 Piano edition due to the current pandemic. This 19th edition of the international competition was to bring together 24 candidates, 17 men and 7 women, aged 20 to 30, representing 11 different countries, including South Korea, the United States, Russia, China and Canada.

Considered one of the most prestigious musical competitions in the world, the CMIM is held annually and features three disciplines (piano, voice, and violin) in a three-year rotation. Since its first edition dedicated to voice in 2002, more than 3,500 hopefuls have entered the Competition and close to 500 have performed in Montreal.

Among the CMIM's noteworthy Laureates are Maesha Brueggergosman, Jamie Barton, Philippe Sly, Benjamin Beilman, Beatrice Rana, Angela Meade and Charles Richard-Hamelin.
